



## **Safety Measures for the 2020 Texas 2-Way Torture Test, Sept. 19, 2020**

Blanco County and Lighthouse Hill Ranch have given us permission to hold this event with the following safety requirements:

- Mandatory temperature checks at packet pickup. If your temperature is 100.4 or greater, you will be asked to leave.
- Additionally, everyone entering the race area will be required to sign a statement stating that they have not experienced any symptoms of COVID-19 (including fever or chills, cough, shortness of breath or difficulty breathing, fatigue, headache, loss of taste or smell) within the last 14 days; that they and their household members have not been diagnosed with COVID-19 or knowingly been exposed to anyone diagnosed with COVID-19 within the last 30 days; and other health and safety statements, along with a waiver.
- Face masks required throughout the event, including at the start and finish area, but not for athletes during the run.

In addition, we'll be taking the following precautions for a safer environment:

- A staggered start with waves of approximately 20 runners per group to help maintain social distancing.
- Chip timing using disposable timing chips only to minimize contact between volunteers and runners and allow for a staggered starts.
- Hand sanitizer will be available for use at multiple locations throughout each event.
- Minimizing contact for distribution of drinks, finisher medals and awards.
- Online posting of preliminary results during the event to maintain social distancing.
- And other measures to reduce potential exposure.
- If we are forced to cancel the event due to COVID-19 related reasons, your entry will be deferred to next year's Torture Test OR you may apply the amount of your entry to any other Run In Texas event.
